Water Bottles

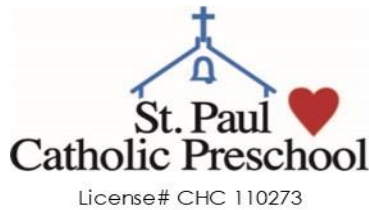
