### Mrs. Overmyer's – 4 Year-Old VPK Class:

- 1 - 24 pack Crayola Crayons
- 1 pack Crayola colored pencils
- 1 pack Crayola washable classic or bold colors, broad line markers
- 2 packs fun/seasonal stickers (No characters)
- 3 packs of 4 count Play-Doh brand (4 oz. cans, any colors)
