Mass of the Lord's Supper

The Sacred Triduum begins tonight! The day starts with Morning Prayer at 7:30am. In accord with ancient tradition, there will be NO Mass at 7:30am or at 12:15pm and no Eucharistic Adoration during the day. The 7:00pm service will include the reception of holy oils and the washing of the feet. After the 7:00pm service, the Most Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist will be reserved in our Chapel of Repose in the Family Center until midnight. Won't you please come, stay awake, and share some quality prayer time with the Lord in the Garden of Gethsemane?

Passion of the Lord

Today, we reflect on the sacrifice Christ made for our salvation. According to the Church's ancient tradition, the Sacraments are neither celebrated today or tomorrow nor is there Eucharistic Adoration. Today is a day of fast and abstinence. All services in Main Church except the Divine Mercy Novena.
