The school will share the following supplies. Please bring them to the Family Center on the night of Family Orientation on August 11th at 6:00pm.

2-Year-Old Classes

- Paper towels
- Nitrile disposable gloves (non-latex)

3-Year-Old Classes

- Lysol spray (Crisp Linen scent)
- Baby wipes (unscented/fragrance-free, like Huggies Natural Care, etc.)

4-Year-Old Classes

- Clorox wipes
- Hand sanitizer 8 oz. with pump

Water Bottles

Children should bring a water bottle to school daily.

- Please label it with your child's first and last name
- No water bottles over 9 inches tall
- Water bottles that contain a straw or spout that is covered when not in use and a handle for carrying is preferred
- Refer to the pictures below for preferred water bottle styles.

The water bottles pictured below are **NOT recommended**. They are too large (taller than 9") or have an open spout.

Miss Ellmaker - 2-Year-Old Class:

- \$5 Walgreen's gift card for photo processing
- 1 Play Doh brand 4 pack any colors (must say for ages 2+)
- 1 package of colored <u>cardstock</u>

The following items are to be taken to your child's classroom during Meet & Greets:

- 1 printed, recent family photo (4x6)
- 1 large Ziplock bag with your child's name on it containing a complete change of clothes (1 top, 1 bottom, underwear, 1 pair of socks) to remain in the classroom all year.
- 1 <u>regular/large backpack with outer side pocket</u> to fit a reusable water bottle, to be brought to school daily
 - Rolling backpacks are not permitted
 - The backpack needs to be able to fit our home/school communication folder regular size folder
 - o Please label on the inside with your child's name
 - A day's supply of diapers and wipes for your child needs to be in their backpack on each day they attend school
