

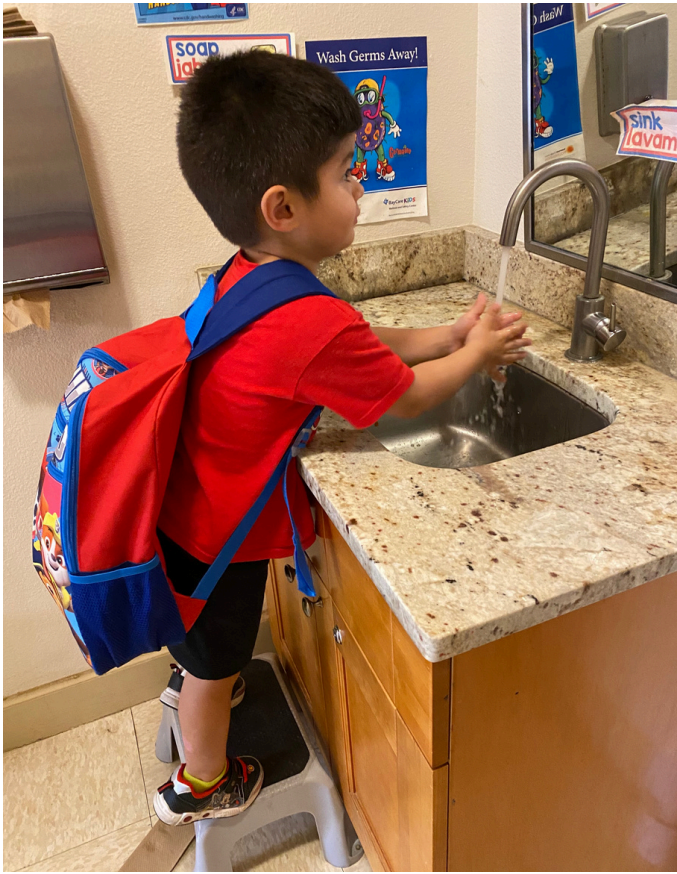


I Go to St. Paul Catholic Preschool

When I get to my classroom, I wash my hands first. Bye-bye germs! Then, I complete my morning routine: I tell my teacher how I feel and I put my backpack away.

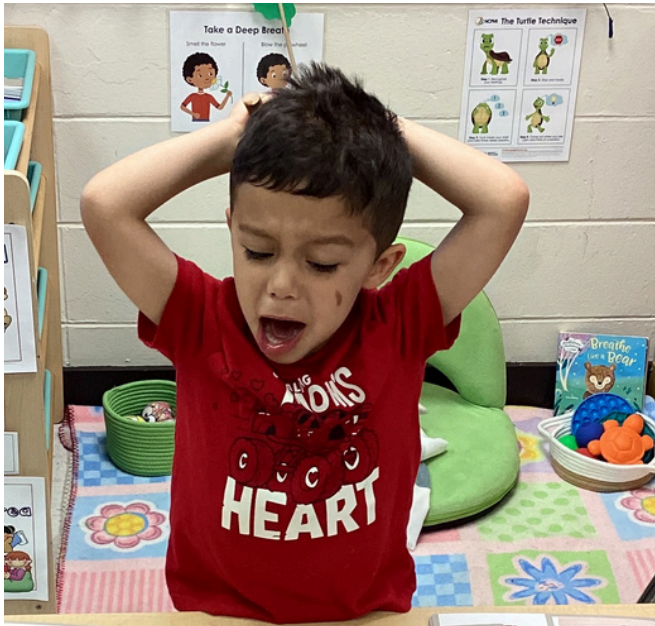


When I am at school:

At school, I use the potty and wash my hands.

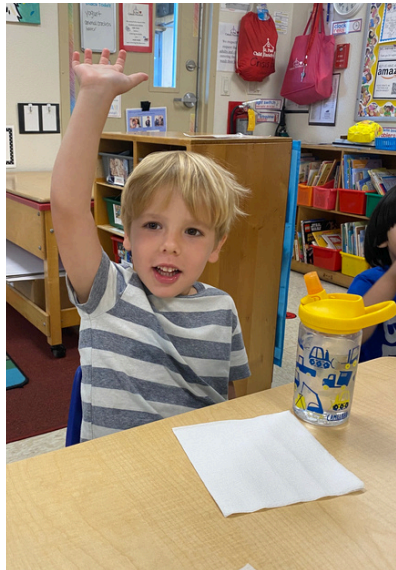
At school, I listen to what my teacher is saying.
